
12. UNIVERSITY REGULATION

Purchaser is required to adhere to all University policies, regulations, guidelines, and all local, provincial and federal laws concerning health, safety and public order. Failure to comply with these regulations may result in forfeiture of the privilege of using University facilities and services, and/or termination of this agreement. University regulations include, but are not limited to, the following in University buildings and on University property:

- 12.1 All individuals will abide by local, provincial, federal law and University regulations regarding intoxicants, narcotics and drugs;
- 12.2 Firearms, weapons, ammunition, fireworks, explosives, pyrotechnics and highly inflammable materials are not allowed anywhere on campus;
- 12.3 Bicycles are not permitted in study rooms, hallways or stairwells or anywhere which may impede emergency evacuation;
- 12.4 Animals (except for guide dogs) are not permitted in any location;
- 12.5 Hot plates or similar appliances are not permitted in rooms nor is any type of cooking allowed in any room except kitchen areas;
- 12.6 Remodelling or renovating of rooms or furniture, tampering with electrical or mechanical fixtures in the rooms, placement of antennas or radios, television, etc. out of the windows, removal of or addition of furniture without arrangement with the Conference Office is not permitted;
- 12.7 Attaching any objects to any University premise by nail, screw, or alteration of the premises in any manner whatsoever without prior permission of the Conference Director is not permitted;
- 12.8 Parking on the road, or in the service or fire lanes anywhere on campus is prohibited;
- 12.9 Tampering with or removal of windows or window screens from any part of any building is not allowed;
- 12.10 Tampering with the fire system or fire fighting equipment is not allowed. It is illegal, subject to a 250 CDN\$ fine by the University and/or legal pursuit;
- 12.11 Removal of lounge or common area furniture into individual rooms is not allowed without prior permission from the Conference Director;
- 12.12 Gambling or solicitation in any form is not permitted;



- 12.13 Bonfires are banned unless a permit has been obtained (application should be made through the University Conference Centre);
- 12.14 It is prohibited to plug into University's telephone system.

13. UNIVERSITY RIGHTS

The University may exercise the following rights:

- 13.1 To enter any room in an emergency, for repair or inspection;
- 13.2 To reassign residents, in order to accomplish necessary repairs and renovation of buildings;
- 13.3 To revoke campus privileges including residency in or utilisation of any of its buildings or any occupant whose conduct, solely in the University's opinion, becomes injurious or potentially injurious to the campus community or contravenes University regulations;
- 13.4 To include telephones in the rooms or not.
