



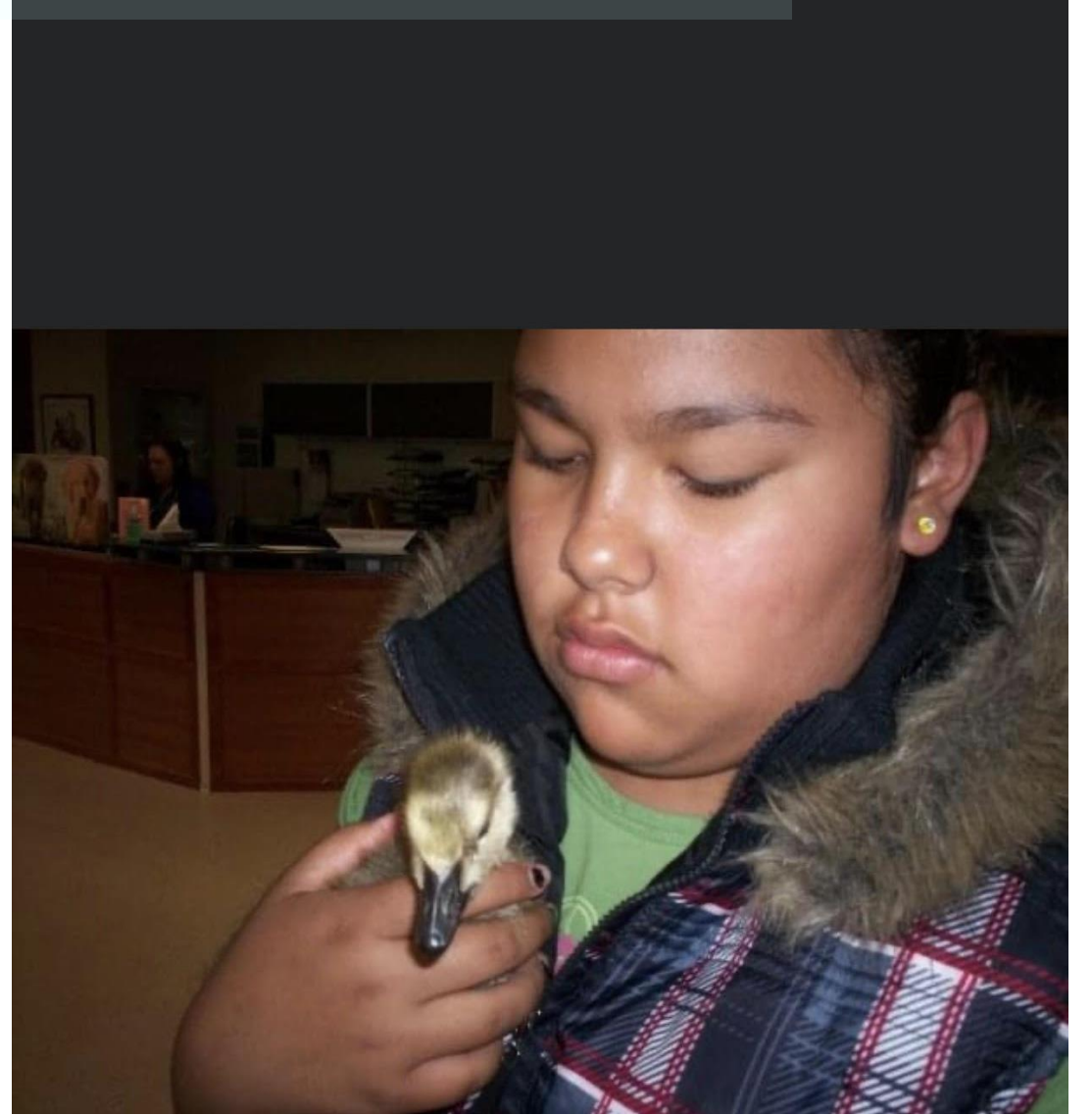

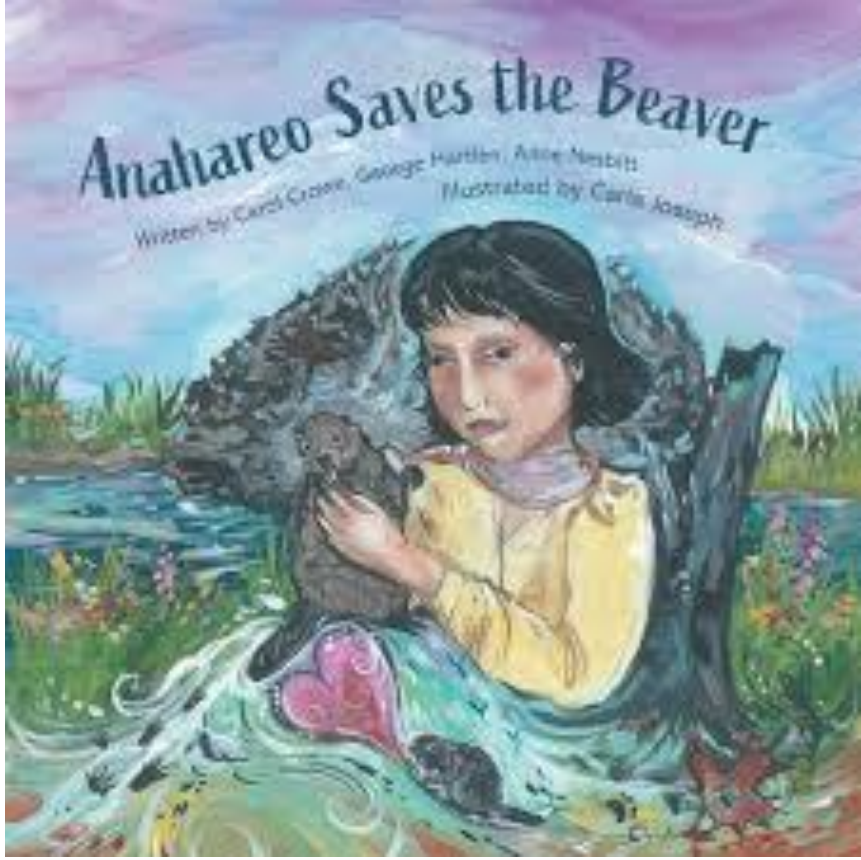
















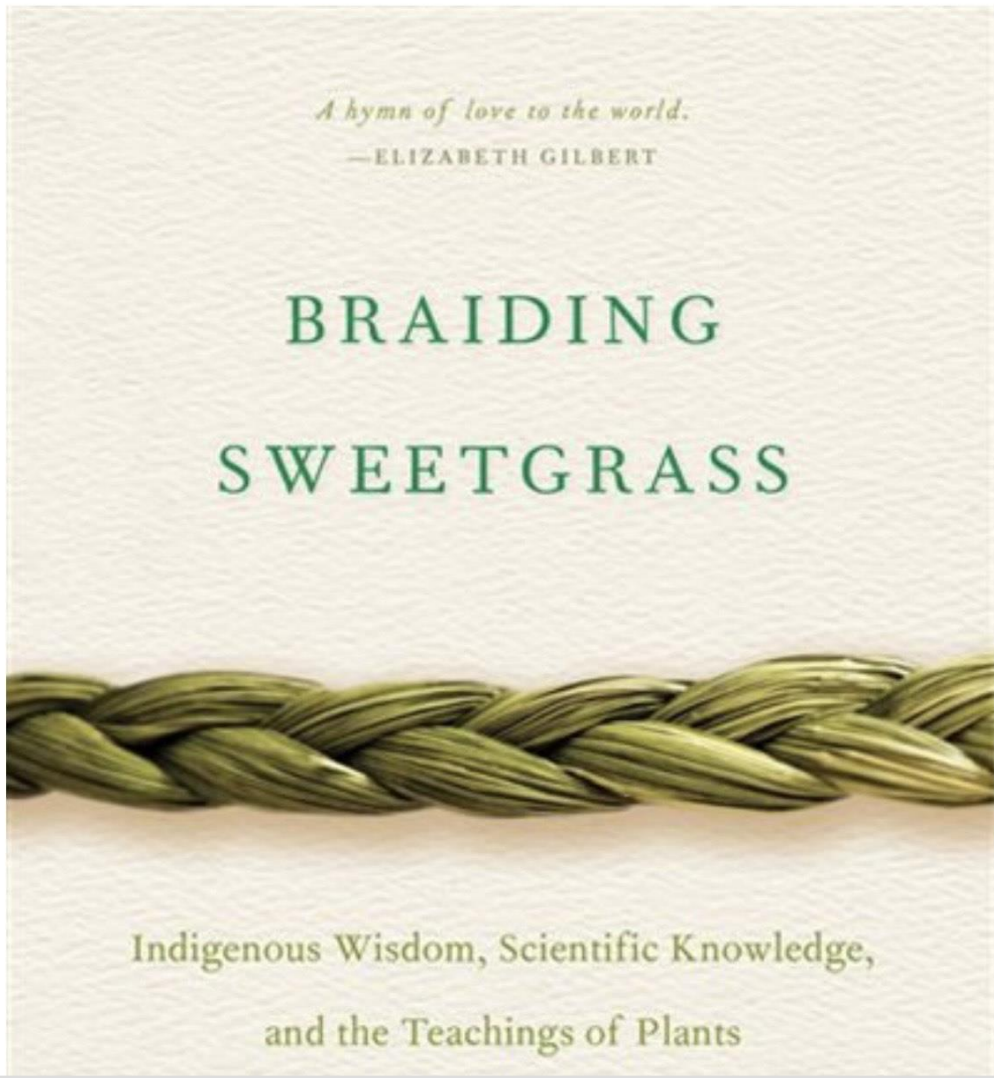


# Traditional Knowledge & Ethical Harvesting


Ceremonies – spiritually led always showing respect for the gifts from mother earth; food & medicine

- Elder Albert Marshall
- Thus, he describes Two-Eyed Seeing as: *“learn to see from your one eye with the best or the strengths in the Indigenous knowledges and ways of knowing ... and learn to see from your other eye with the best or the strengths in the mainstream (Western or Eurocentric) knowledges and ways of knowing ... but most importantly, learn to see with both these eyes together, for the benefit of all”*.
